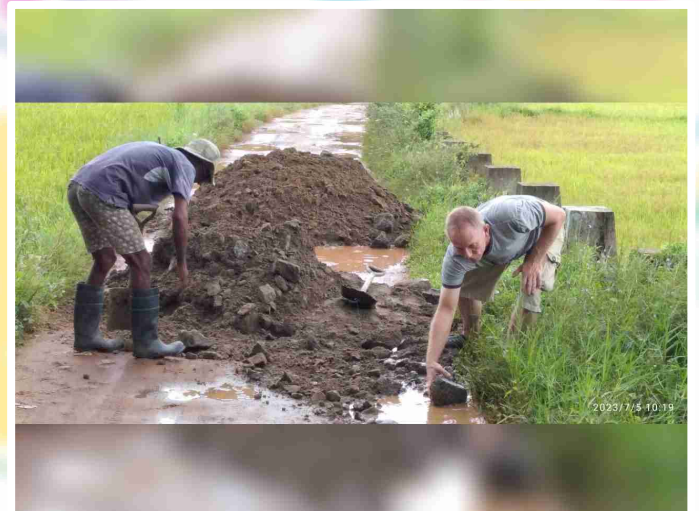
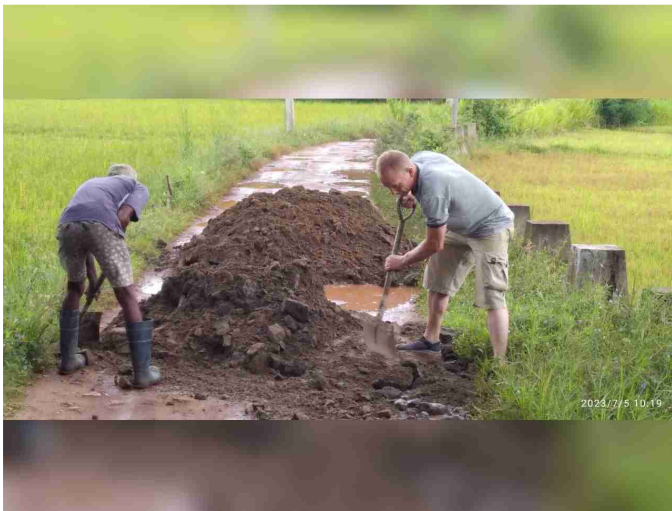
2023.07.03

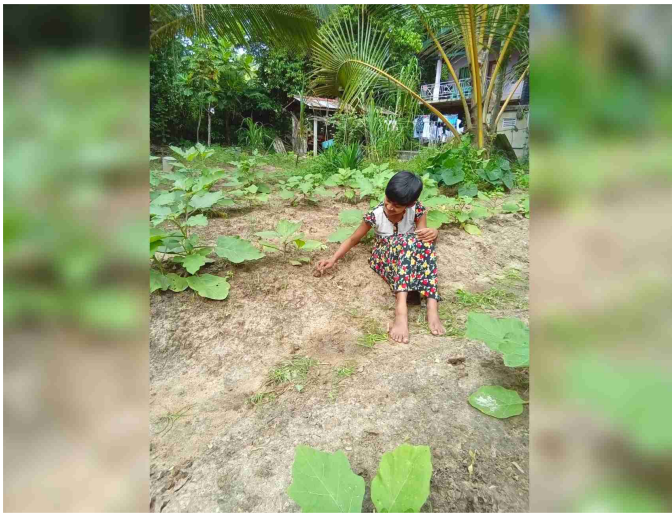
2023.07.05

Prepared the polythene covers required for planting vegetable and fruit seeds.

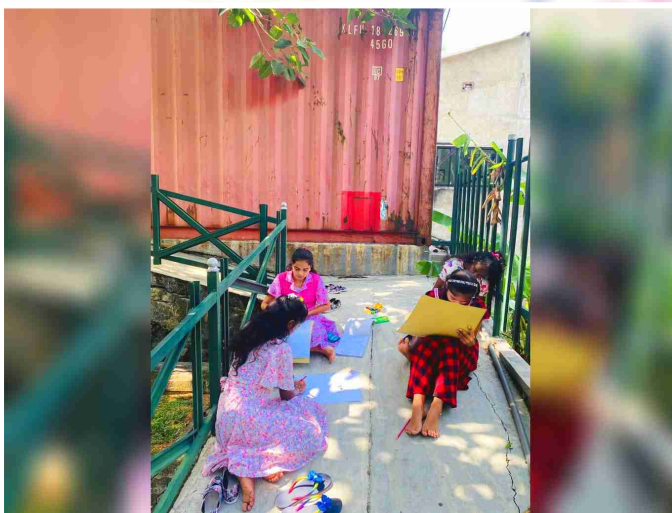
2023.07.22

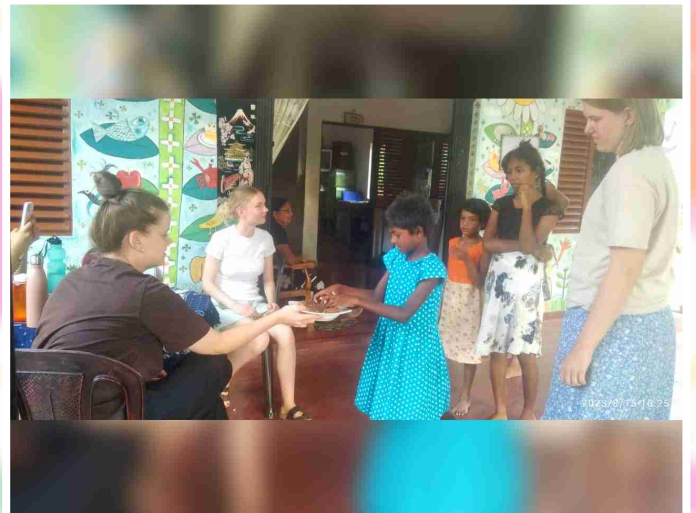
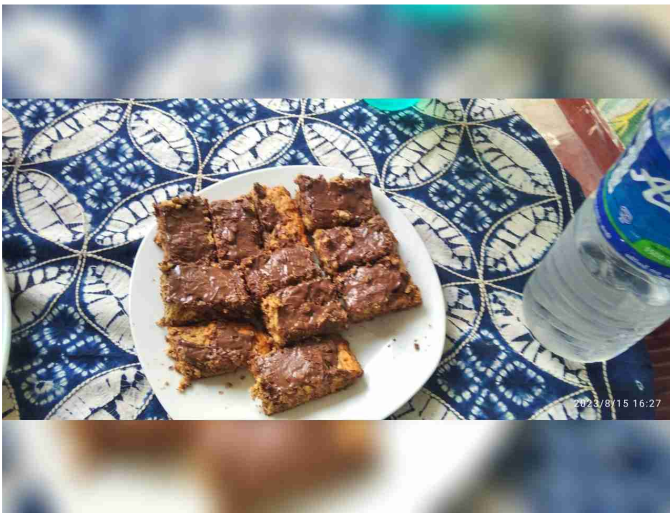
Anuradhapura tour,

Danish friends made Halapa together with our daughters.



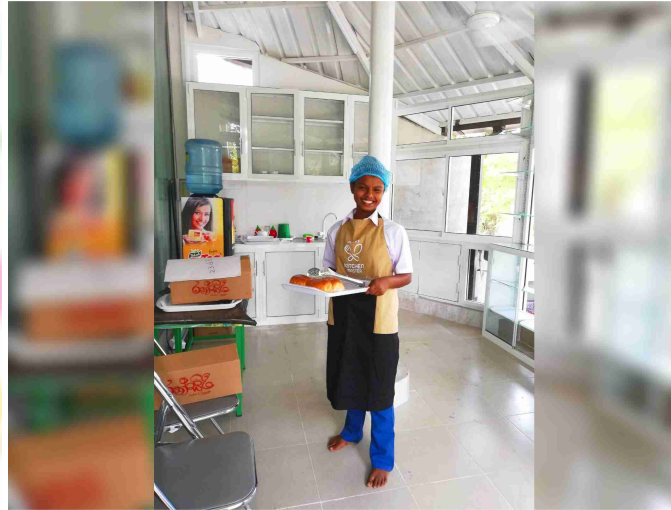
2023.09.02

She is currently studying Japanese at the Faculty of Japanese Language Studies at Kurashiki University of Science and Technology, Japan. Her future hope is to study primary education and provide her services to children as a teacher.
